## God of light, Bless our home.

In a season of new beginnings, we choose how we want to enter into a new year. Often we make resolutions about what our focus for the new year will be. In the past I have offered you chances to pick star words to focus on or questions about how we want to live as a community.

This year, I think it is important for us to recognize, welcome, and share blessings with one another. The time of Epiphany is a recognition of who God is in our lives. We start with the story of the Magi who bear gifts for a king and messiah to the child Jesus. We see the heavens torn open and hear the voice of God proclaiming Jesus as his Son. We witness Jesus performing miracles like turning water into wine. All of these things bear blessings in the stories and in our lives. At the time of Epiphany it is traditional for us to begin the year by blessing our homes and all those who live there, visit there, and pass through those doors.

The following is a home blessing written by one of my colleagues that you can use in your own home. A piece of chalk, crayon or pencil will work well to mark your home with a blessing for this new year. May your life be filled with the revelation of who God is here and now in your life. And may you live this year as a blessing to those you encounter.

The Epiphany Home Blessing is a way of marking our homes, usually at the front door or main entrance, with sacred signs and symbols as we chalk God's blessing upon those who live, work or visit throughout the year. In Exodus, the Israelites marked their doors with blood so that the Lord would pass over their homes; but in this service we mark our doors with chalk as a sign that we have invited Gods presence and blessing into our homes.

In Deuteronomy 6:9 God tells the people of Israel: "These words that I command you today share be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children and shall talk of them when you sit in your house. You shall write them on the doorpost of your house and on

your gates." Chalking the door is a tangible way to honor God in our lives.

#### What do the numbers and letters mean?

The first and last numbers simply refer to our current year. The letters C M B come from the traditional names for the three kings: Caspar, Melchoir and Balthazar. Some also suggest "Christus Mansionem Benedict" which means "May Christ bless this dwelling"

#### How It's Done:

Mark the door or doors people use to enter and leave your home with the symbol of blessing: 20+C+M+B+25.

You may say: The three wise men, Caspar (write C), Melchoir (write M) and Balthazar (write B) followed the star of God's Son who became human two thousand (write the 20 to the right of the letters) and twenty-five years ago (write a 25 to the left of the letters). May Christ bless our home and remain with us throughout the new year. (Draw a cross between each letter/number) Amen.

You may want to say the following prayer after you chalk the door:

God of light, Bless our home.

Bless all who come and go through the door, both those who live here and those who visit. May all who enter through this door come in peace and find love and light. May the love and joy in this home overflow and spread. Christ has come to dwell in this home and in these hearts.

#### TREASURER'S DISCUSSION

- Receipts for November totaled \$22.8K. YTD our receipts total \$243.5K, which is ahead of our budget by about \$13.5K.
- Spending totaled \$23.4K and was over our monthly budget. YTD our spending totals \$240K, which is about \$7.8K overbudget. We paid a semi-annual workman's comp insurance premium in November which was scheduled for December. Several other expenses, mostly in property, were over-budget.
- Net, for November we had a deficit of \$619. YTD we have a surplus of \$3,434.
- · Here's the update this month on building costs, which include our Property (operating) Expenses and our Property Re-

- At the end of the month, the Property Reserve Account had a balance of \$5,188.
- In November, <u>PDO</u> had receipts of \$18.8K and expenses of \$17.6K. PDO had a surplus in November of \$1.1K. PDO has a deficit YTD of \$1K. The financial picture has been improving since September.
- The balances in the Reserve and Restricted Funds at the end of the month are shown below.
