Who are you?

"Who are you?"

This seems a relatively simple question. Only three words. It is a question that we might answer with our name or our profession. Depending on the scenario it might also involve responding with our relationship to another individual. But whenever I hear or see this question I am reminded of the Disney adaptation of Alice in Wonderland and the conversation between Alice and the Blue Caterpillar.

When asked "who are you?" by the Blue Caterpillar, Alice's response is so interesting. She says, "I hardly know sir, I've changed so many times since this morning you see." While it might seem that this answer lacks self-awareness I believe it shows us the opposite. Alice is aware that nothing is truly as she believed it was before this morning, and therefore she knows that she too is different. And rather than claiming to be who she was before her adventure began she wrestles with the everchanging world around her and its profound effect on her person.

This question has come up recently in council meetings, not for us individually, but self-reflectively and corporately as a church. Who are we?

It is not a simple question to answer. Not only because it entails understanding the dynamics between all of us who are a part of the church, but also because it must take into account the world around us and the vast changes that have been happening and continue to happen around us. We are not a church in a vacuum that is unaffected by cultural or political changes. We are not frozen in time and ageless. We are a dynamic community that is (in good Lutheran-speak) always being made new.

So there is no easy answer to the question. Just as our community changes and grows constantly, we have to continue to ask the question "who are we?" and grow into the new understanding of ourselves. But even as we are being made new, we know that there are core traits of our congregation. We are a community who gathers to worship and receive God's grace. We are a people of faith who seek to serve others as we follow the way of Jesus.

How we embody these intrinsic attributes in the world around us will continue to evolve. As we move into a new year of programs and activities I would like us to consider again the question, "who are we?" How have we changed and grown in the last year? What is new about our community? How will we continue to engage our faith in the world around us? And what can our church do to continue to be a vital congregation in the world today?

TREASURER'S DISCUSSION

- Receipts for July totaled \$21.3K, which were under our monthly budget by about \$300. YTD our receipts total \$166.8K which is about \$13.2K over budget.
- Spending totaled \$20.4K and was under our monthly budget by about \$1.1K. YTD Spending totals \$152.9K which is about \$4.8K under budget.
- Net, for July we had a surplus of \$975. YTD we have a surplus of \$13,916.
- In July, <u>PDO</u> had receipts of \$1,257 and expenses of \$8,401. PDO held two summer camps and paid for salaries and expenses in July, but most of the camp registrations had been paid for in previous months. PDO had a deficit in July of \$7,144. YTD, the PDO operating account has a surplus of \$5,976. This is sufficient to cover the cost of the one remaining camp in August.
- In July, the Quilter's Leaders decided to transfer the funds from the Quilter's Reserve Fund established last month into their own separate checking account at Great Southern Bank. That fund will no longer appear as a Reserve Fund in the list below.
- Both the Trinity Foundation (see above) and the Seminary Education Fund (see below) have funds deposited in the ELCA's Pooled Investment Trust. Both Funds saw good appreciation in their investments during the second quarter 2025.
